75% of 3rd Graders Struggle to Read This Sentence.







It is hard for kids to achieve in school when they are falling behind in reading or don't have caring adults to help them when they are struggling. That's why the Y partners with schools to enhance learning by providing enrichment programs and academic interventions that help thousands of youth build skills and confidence.

3 out of 4 third graders are not reading at grade level.

Since 2012, **over 3,000 children** have received **1:1 Y literacy tutoring** with **90% achieving gains** in reading.

Each year, **over 20,000 youth** participate in structured **YMCA programs** after school where they can **learn and grow.**

Children from low-income families are three times less likely to participate in after-school learning programs.

There is an average of **1 counselor** to every **350+ students** in schools leaving many **without help** in planning for their future.

Over **300 YMCA Black and Latino Achievers** have received guidance, resulting in **over \$1.3M in scholarships!**
